ARE YOU PET READY?

In the event of a hurricane there are 4 Pet Friendly Shelters:

- Port St. John Community Center - 6650 Corto Road
- Viera Regional Park - 2300 Judge Fran Jamieson Way
- Wickham Park Community Center - 2815 Leisure Way
- Palm Bay Regional Park - 1951 NW Malabar Road

These shelters are open to people and pets in MANDATORY evacuation areas ONLY! Shelter openings are incident-specific. Never go to a shelter unless local officials have announced it is open.

When you go to a shelter you WILL NEED:

- Current rabies vaccination certificate
- County animal license tags
- Pet food
- Medications
- Leash and Collar
- Crate or cage
- Cleaning supplies
- Comfort items for your pet



If you are not in a mandatory evacuation area and you decide to leave, you MUST make arrangements for your pets to go with you. Pets should not be left behind unattended.
