NARRATIVE

Synopsis:

On Sunday, December 9, 2018, at approximately 1515 hours, I received a request from Brevard County Sheriff's Office (BCSO) Crime Scene Unit Sergeant (Sgt.) T. Laufenberg, ID 0415, in reference to assisting with an injured/ill person investigation at the BCSO Jail Complex, 860 Camp Road, Cocoa, Brevard County, FL. 1 complied with this request and arrived at approximately 1600 hours. BCSO Homicide Unit Agent (Agt.) J. Straight, ID 0442, assumed lead investigative duties for this case. Crime Scene Investigator (CSI) L. Cox, ID 4112, assumed the role of lead CSI. Refer to their reports for complete details.

I photographed two scenes, items of evidence, and involved deputies.

I completed my assignment and departed the Jail Complex at approximately 1940 hours.

On December 12, 2018, I photographed an additional deputy involved in this investigation.

Submissions were made to BCSO Records Management System and Evidence Unit.

Information Provided:

Upon my arrival, I met with Agt. Straight who gave me the following case details: Mr. Gregory Edwards was brought into the jail by West Melbourne Police Department (WMPD) at approximately 1325 hours on the same date. He was initially placed in holding cell 7 during booking. When deputies attempted to remove him from cell 7 he became combative and injured BCSO Correction when deputies attempted to remove him from cell At this point multiple BCSO corrections deputies restrained Mr. Edwards and placed him into a restraint chair. During the incident, BCSO Corrections Deputy A. Blazewicz, ID 2080, used her department issued Taser on Mr. Edwards.

After the incident, Mr. Edwards was placed in cell 9 of the booking area. Subsequently Mr. Edwards became unresponsive. He was transported to the Jail Complex's Infirmary where we was treated by the medical personnel there. He was then transported to Rockledge Regional Medical Center.

I spoke with BCSO Corrections Deputy R. Wagner, ID 1121, who directed me to Mr. Edwards' personal belongings collected during booking.

Scene Description:

Two different scenes were documented during my investigation at the Jail Complex: The booking area, including cells 7 and 9, and the Infirmary.

The booking area consists of a large central area with multiple offices/holding cells around the central area. Holding cells 7, 8, and 9 are located on the northwest side of the booking area with cell 7 being south of cell 8 and cell 8 being south of cell 9. I observed small pieces of pink and yellow confetti and two small pieces of green plastic on the floor immediately southeast of cell 8. These confetti pieces are consistent with a Taser being discharged in this area.

I did not observe any areas of interest in the holding cells.

Later on I was directed by BCSO Homicide Unit Lieutenant (Lt.) R. Vitaliano, ID 0003, to a sharps container located on the wall of an office on the southwest side of the booking area. Two Taser prongs with attached wires were located in the sharps container. They were initially wrapped in a PPE glove. The glove was removed and discarded. The tips of the prongs had suspected blood on them.

Mr. Edwards' personal belongings included a black Seiko watch, a grey metal ring, a pair of white headphones, a pair of blue/black New Balance flip flops, a pair of camo shorts with a brown belt, a black Underarmour shirt, and a pair of plaid boxer briefs.

The Infirmary of the Jail Complex consisted of a large central area with smaller rooms around it. A hallway led from the central area to the surrounding rooms. A portion of the medical area appeared to have sectioned off. I was advised by BCSO Corrections Deputy D. Edward, ID 2150, this sectioned off area was where the medical staff worked on Mr. Edwards. Medical waste items and a small reddish brown drip stain were located in this area,

Deputy Edward also directed me to the restraint chair Mr. Edwards was previously seated in. The chair had reportedly been moved but was in one of the medical rooms upon my arrival.

The medical staff also directed me to the AED and the AED pads/packaging used on Mr. Edwards. These items were located in the central room of the Infirmary. Specifically the AED was on a desk near the section off area of the hallway. The used AED pads and packaging were in a trash bin near the AED.

No other areas of interest were observed within the scene.

I inquired with each deputy if they received any injuries or damage to their uniform/equipment.

Deputy Wagner had a cut to the webbing portion of his right hand, damage to his personal eyeglasses, and damage to the Velcro of the left front pocket of his uniform shirt.

No other injuries/damage were observed on any of the other deputies or their equipment/uniform.

Scene Photography:

I photographed the scenes including items of evidence and areas of interest. Each deputy was photographed to include their front, back, sides, and their hands. The injury to Deputy Wagner, his eyeglasses, and his uniform shirt were also photographed.

All photographs were taken using a Nikon D7200 digital camera.

Evidence Collection:

I collected the pieces of confetti and plastic from the floor of the booking area. The Taser prongs were collected. Deputy Wagner's shirt was collected.

Mr. Edwards' personal belongings were signed for and received on an inmate personal belonging receipt.

NARRATIVE

On Sunday, December 9, 2018, at approximately 1514 hours, I received a request from Brevard County Sheriff's Office (BCSO) Crime Scene Unit (CSU) Sergeant (Sgt.) T. Laufenberg, ID 0415. Sgt. Laufenberg requested I respond to Rockledge Regional Medical Center (RRMC), 110 Longwood St., Rockledge, Brevard County, Florida, in reference to an injured/ill person investigation. I complied with this request and arrived at RRMC at approximately 1552 hours.

BCSO Homicide Unit Agent (Agt.) J. Straight, ID 0446, assumed lead investigative duties. Refer to her report for further information regarding this investigation.

BCSO Crime Scene Investigator (CSI) C. Schneider, ID 1073, responded to the Brevard County Sheriff's Office Jail, 860 Camp Rd., Cocoa, Brevard County, Florida. CSI Schneider collected items of evidence and photographed various locations in the jail as well as multiple BCSO Correction Deputies. On Wednesday, December 12, 2018, CSI Schneider also re-photographed Correction Deputy (Dep.) A. Blazewicz, ID 2080, and her injuries. Refer to his report for more information.

The following information was provided to me: Mr. Gregory Edwards was arrested by the West Melbourne Police Department, and was transported to the BCSO jail. Mr. Edwards was placed into a holding cell. When BCSO orrection the provided of the BCSO jail. Mr. Edwards was placed into a holding cell. When BCSO became combative and was eventually sprayed with chemical agent. Mr. Edwards was still resisting and was Tased by Dep. Blazewicz. Mr. Edwards was handcuffed and placed into a restraint chair. Mr. Edwards was then placed into a different cell. A short time later, he was found unresponsive and brought to the medical unit while still in the restraint chair. Mr. Edwards was given CPR and Narcan by BCSO jail staff. Brevard County Fire Rescue (BCFR) responded and transported Mr. Edwards to RRMC. Correction Deputy Blazewicz and the were both injured while trying to restrain Mr. Edwards. It should be noted, Mr. Edwards had a history of PTSD and hallucinations.

Mr. Edwards was originally observed in Emergency Room 19. Mr. Edwards was later moved to the Intensive Care Unit Room number 502. Mr. Edwards was supine on a hospital bed. His feet and right hand were in handcuffs connected with shackles. Medical intervention equipment was in/on his right and left lower legs, his upper and lower left arm, his left wrist, the left side of his torso, the upper left and right areas of his chest, the right side of his torso, his upper right arm, and his mouth. Abrasions were on the top of his left foot, the top of his second left toe, the second knuckle on his right hand, his left arm, above the elbow, and his back. Scratches were on his left hip, on the left side of his face, below his ear, and the left side of his chest, his left and right forearms, his right shoulder, his right arm, his right hand, his upper left thigh, near his hip, his chest, his left and right forearms, his right shoulder, his right and left sides of his forehead, and the left side of his face, below his ear. Several circular, raised areas, consistent with Taser probes, were on his right side and the right side of his back, near his hip. Several cuts and linear contusions/discoloration, consistent with resisting while being handcuffed, were around both wrists. He was also bleeding from his groin. A scar was on his left knee. His Brevard County Jail Complex issued red shirt

and pair of red pants (LC1) were underneath him.

Mr. Edwards and his injuries/scars were photographed utilizing a Nikon D7200 digital camera. Injuries and scars were photographed with, and without, a measuring device in place.

Items of evidence were collected and documented on a property receipt as follows:

LC1: (1) Red shirt and (1) pair of red pants

I departed from RRMC at approximately 1720 hours.

I then responded to BCSO Criminal Investigative Services (CIS) Building, 340 Gus Hipp Blvd., Rockledge, Brevard County, Florida.

Abrasions and a scratch were on finner left wrist. An abrasion was on his left arm, above the elbow. A scratch was on his inner right arm. An area of discoloration was on his inner right elbow and on the back right side of his head. A raised area was on the top of his forehead, a scratch was on the top of his head, and an abrasion was derneath his left eye.

and his injuries were photographed utilizing a Nikon D7200 digital camera. Injuries were photographed with, and without, a measuring device in place.

Contusions were on Dep. Blazewicz's right forearm and the back of her upper right arm. A scratch was on her lower right arm. An abrasion was on her right arm, above the elbow. Dep. Blazewicz and her injuries were photographed utilizing a Nikon D7200 digital camera. Injuries were photographed with, and without, a measuring device in place.

Dep. Blazewicz's BCSO issued green shirt (AB1), green pants (AB2), and Taser (AB3) were collected and documented on a property receipt as follows:

AB1: Green 5.11 Tactical Deputy shirt, size large (Deputy A. Blazewicz) AB2: Pair of green 5.11 Tactical Deputy pants, size 40 X 32 (Deputy A. Blazewicz) AB3: Taser X26, serial number X00-243382 (issued to Deputy A. Blazewicz)

utilizing a Nikon D7200 digital camera. Areas of suspected bloodstaining were photographed with, and without, a measuring device in place.

Areas of suspected bloodstaining were on the top, front right and left legs, on the front and side of the right leg, midway down, on the front side of the lower left leg, on the top right leg on the backside of the pants, on the back side of the pants, near the right side of the waistband, and on the back right leg of the pants, midway down the pants of LC1 (1 Red shirt and 1 pair of red pants). A saturation stain of suspected blood was on/below the waistband and center on the backside of the pants and a transfer pattern of suspected blood was on the back right leg, midway down. The pants were cut down the front of each leg.

Areas of suspected bloodstaining were on various areas of the front left and right sleeves, the front midsection, the front lower section, the back side of the right sleeve, and the back side near the midsection of the red shirt of LC1 (1 Red shirt and 1 pair of red pants). A saturation stain of suspected blood was on the backside of the left sleeve. The shirt was cut across the front of each sleeve and down the front right side. The shirt was labeled on the back with the number two.

The broken glasses (1BM), the cracked watch (2BM), and the orange Rugged Earth shirt (3BM) were received in plastic bag. The Rugged Earth shirt (3BM) was ripped along the left side of the chest horizontally to the side of the sleeve as well as vertically up to the collar.

It should be noted, the Taser cartridge (PU1) was wrapped with three gloves.

All items of evidence were secured within the CIS building.

On Tuesday, December 11, 2018, at approximately 0715 hours, Agt. Straight informed me Mr. Edwards was pronounced deceased at approximately 2000 hours on Monday, December 10, 2018.

On Tuesday, December 11, 2018, at approximately 0820 hours, I was present at the Brevard County Medical Examiner's Office (BCMEO), 1750 Cedar St., Rockledge, Brevard County, Florida, for the autopsy of the decedent. The BCMEO case number is 18-953. The autopsy was performed by Chief Medical Examiner Dr. S. Qaiser with the assistance of Forensic Technicians T. Mounsey and F. Simpson.

In addition to the injuries noted on scene, contusions/discoloration were observed on his knees, on his left forearm, his left forearm near the elbow, his inner left elbow, and the back of his left upper arm, his left hip, his right side, his right arm, near the elbow, the right side of his chest, and his left and right cheeks. A scratch was on the right side of his upper back. Patterns of contusions, consistent with medical intervention equipment, were on his chest. Bite-marks were on the inside of his mouth and on his tongue.

¹+ems of evidence were collected and documented on a property receipt as follows:

ME1: FTA card ME2: L fingernail clippings + clippers ME3: R fingernail clippings ME4: L, R, and C hair w/tweezers ME5: Set of left and right fingerprints, set of left and right palm prints, and a set of left and right footprints.

I departed from the BCMEO at approximately 1205 hours.

All items of evidence were transported to, and secured within, the CIS Building.

On Tuesday, December 18, 2018, at approximately 1039 hours, I signed for and received items of evidence from Agt. Straight. The items were described on a property receipt as follows:

1BM: Pair blue glasses - broken

2BM: Yellow/gry watch scratched/cracked

3BM: Orange Rugged Earth shirt sz XXL ripped w/bag
