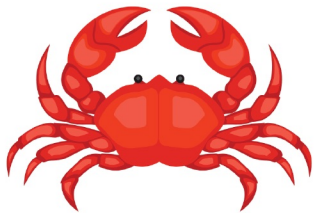




EXPLORING NATURE WITH SAINT
